### CHAPTER THREE

#### USE OF DEPARTMENT VEHICLES

The East Tawakoni Police Marine Unit is responsible for policing the shorelines within the limits of the cities waters from the Two Mile Bridge to South of Clyde's Marina.

**The unit is made up of one Safety Marine Officer who is a Tcleose Certified Police Officer with the State of Texas and Reserve patrol officers.**

**The main functions of the Marine Policing Unit are:**

- waterborne response to incidents
- Shoreline patrol of all city waterfront and enforcement of fishing from causeways
- Investigating marine-related crime
- Searching for and recovering missing property
- Providing core policing support on water and in waterfront areas
- Gathering, collating and investigating all marine offenses on shorelines
- High visibility patrols
- Carrying out multi-agency initiatives with Texas Park and Wildlife and other Agencies needing assistances
- Public reassurance
- Crime prevention initiatives
- Boater safety within the shorelines

**THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THE MARINE BOAT AS FOLLOWS WITH NO EXCEPTIONS:**

To patrol the shorelines of the city of East Tawakoni within it's city limits

To enforce the laws of city ordinances and the State of Texas

To prevent the lose of property along the shorelines, boathouses, & boats

The marine boat will be used in any boaters accident or drowning to asst TP&W

The marine boat will not be used for any recreational or personal use

The marine boat will only be operated by a Certified Marine Safety Officers through TP&W

There will be no riders in the marine boat except certified police officers & those in an emergency

Situation (boat duress, drowning and life and death situations.

The marine boat will be housed or stored at the East Tawakoni Police Dept.
