

**AMENDMENT  
CODE OF ORDINANCES  
CHAPTER 62 SEC. 62-121  
CITY OF EAST TAWAKONI, TEXAS**

**Inoperable , Junked or Wrecked Vehicles**

For the purpose of this section the following definitions shall apply.

1. Inoperable, Junked or wrecked vehicle means a vehicle that is self-propelled and :

(A) Does not have lawfully attached to it:

(a) an unexpired license plate : or

(b) a valid motor vehicle inspection certificate:

B. or is :

(a) wrecked, dismantled or partially dismantled or discarded or

(b) inoperable and has remained inoperable for more than 30 consecutive days on private property .

2. Public Nuisance Vehicle :

.is an Inoperable, junked or wrecked vehicle that is visible at any time of the year from a public place or public right of way or adjacent private property :

3. Special interest vehicle :


Is a properly stored vehicle that is being restored or is temporarily disabled

4. Proper storage of a Special Interest vehicle

is completely enclosed in a building or appropriately covered and is from public view by a properly fitted vehicle cover specifically manufactured and designed for an automobile (No all purpose Tarps).

All vehicles within the city limits of East Tawakoni that are inoperable, junked or wrecked as defined above shall be properly covered. after reasonable attempts to contact the registered owner of the vehicle or property owner when on private property have been made and city official are unable to get a inoperable , junked or wrecked vehicle properly covered they shall follow the guidelines laid out in Texas Transportation code 683.071 - 683.078 for proper abatement and disposal of the vehicle(s) .
