## 18. Mayor Comments

- I want to thank Judge Craig for conducting the swearing in of your newly elected council members and mayor. Your city government officials serve at the pleasure of the citizens who elected us and we pledge to faithfully perform our duties in the best interest of everyone we represent. A big thanks to all our citizens who participated in any way with campaigns and by voting in the election. Each of us deeply appreciate the many times and ways in which you have expressed your confidence in us to govern on your behalf. Thank you.
- Out of respect for our citizens and council members time spent during council meetings the following protocols are to be immediately enacted. The fact is, we have allowed ourselves to establish a pattern of social liberties of open dialogue and bantering from the floor that can disrupt the continuity of addressing our agenda items. This impacts the time required for Council to do the job for which they were elected. The following list of generally accepted rules that are intended to address these concerns:
  - All persons wishing to speak must, prior to the meeting, must submit to the City Secretary a completed written application with your name and topic
  - Raising of hands for permission to speak will not be automatically be recognized by the "Chair" unless there is a medical emergency or emanate threat to safety
  - There is a time and place for open dialogue for citizens to interact with public officials.
     To that end Council Members have expressed a desire to conduct routine Town Hall meetings. Details of which will soon follow.
- The annual Spring Cleanup Event was held last Friday & Saturday on the hill at the top of the HWY 276 city property. Multiple dumpsters were filled with trash and debris by citizens who came to dispose of large volumes of trash and items you can't put in a trashcan. A BIG thank you to the Public Works Dept. who worked both days to monitor and separate the items collected and assist with unloading trucks and trailers as needed.
- During 4<sup>th</sup> QTR 2025 & 1<sup>st</sup> QTR 2025 the water dept. reported a significant volume of water loss over a 4-month period. Analysis indicated two p rime factors.
  - I. High numbers of estimated water meter readings over multiple months of which required clerical interpretation. Most of those estimates were less than actual consumption. When actual reads were recorded customers were billed the true volume used which was typically higher than normally expected.
  - 2. Extraordinary number of waterlines breaks during the harsh winter months. Some breaks were on the city mains, others on residential plumbing. All major leaks have been repaired including replacing a fire hydrant.
- The event held on Sat May 10<sup>th</sup>. The Nautical Mile "Fun-Run" and 5-K race was enhanced by the addition of the 400 YD Victory Dash participants paid no fees to participate and each was awarded a medal by a Rains ISD Cheerleaders at the finish line. A total of 118 individuals registered for this year's event.
